The Grand Jury charges:

THE CONSPIRACY AND ITS OBJECTS

1. From in or around July 2004 and continuing thereafter until in or around July 2007, in the Western District of Pennsylvania and elsewhere, the defendant, ANDREA REVAK, knowingly and willfully did conspire, combine, confederate and agree with other persons known to the Grand Jury, to commit an offense against the United States, that is, Wire Fraud, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1343.

MANNER AND MEANS OF THE CONSPIRACY

2. It was a part of the conspiracy that the defendant, ANDREA REVAK, with the assistance of other members of the conspiracy, applied for loans to purchase properties in the Western District of Pennsylvania, including the properties located at the following addresses:

436 Hays Avenue
Pittsburgh, PA 15210

132 Freemont Street
Pittsburgh, PA 15210

141 Margaret Street
Pittsburgh, PA 15210

124 Laughlin Avenue
Pittsburgh, PA 15210

716 McLain Street
Pittsburgh, PA 15210

1623 Leolyn Street
Pittsburgh, PA 15210

3. It was further a part of the conspiracy that the defendant, ANDREA REVAK, with the assistance of other members of the conspiracy, made material misrepresentations in connection with the loan applications about her financial condition.

4. It was further a part of the conspiracy that other members of the conspiracy submitted false documents in connection with the loan applications, and the loan applications of other borrowers, such documents including but not limited to, verifications of employment, verifications of deposit, appraisals, paystubs, and W-2s.


5. It was further a part of the conspiracy that the defendant, ANDREA REVAK, participated in conspiracy by arranging for fraudulent appraisals and by processing paperwork associated with fraudulent loan applications.


6. It was further a part of the conspiracy that other members of the conspiracy caused wire transfers from the accounts of the lending institutions, located outside the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, to the accounts of the closing agents located in the

Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in furtherance of the Wire Fraud scheme.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1349.
