**NATURE OF PROCEEDINGS:**

**SENTENCE-NON CONTESTED-20 minutes**

**SENTENCE-** term of 33 months on each of Counts One and Two, to be served concurrently.

**SUPERVISED RELEASE:** 3 years. This term consists of terms of 3 years on each of Counts One and Two, all such terms to run concurrently.

Based on information presented, the defendant is excused from the mandatory drug testing provision; however, the defendant may be requested to submit to drug testing during the period of supervision if the probation officer determines a risk of substance abuse.

**SPECIAL CONDITIONS:**

**NEW DEBT RESTRICTIONS**

You are prohibited from incurring any new credit charges, opening additional lines of credit, or incurring any new monetary loan, obligation, or debt, by whatever name known, without the approval of the U.S. Probation Office. You shall not encumber or liquidate interest in any assets unless it is in direct service of the fine and/or restitution obligation or otherwise has the expressed approval of the Court.

**SPECIAL ASSESSMENT:** \$200, which shall be due immediately.

**VOLUNTARILY SURRENDER:**

It is further ordered that the defendant surrender herself to the institution designated by, and on the date set by, the Bureau of Prisons. The Court recommends that the Bureau of Prisons designate a facility for service of this sentence as near as possible to the defendant's home address.
